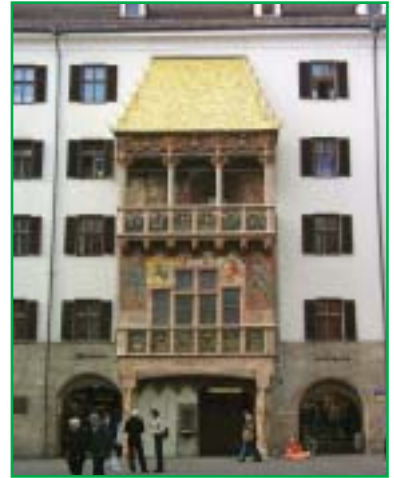


INFORMAL GET-TOGETHER PARTY
